## *Road Closures, Deliveries & Parking Plans for 2017 Fall TEMPE FESTIVAL OF THE ARTS*

**Tempe, AZ** – Today the Downtown Tempe Authority announced the following information for affected merchants and businesses regarding street closures, traffic rerouting, and parking and transportation information for the upcoming December 1 - 3 Tempe Festival of the Arts. Please be advised that parking will be prohibited in affected locations for several hours prior to road closures:

### **STREET CLOSURES SCHEDULE:**

The following streets will close on **Thursday, November 30:**

#### Approximately 7:00 a.m. Closure (Peripheral Street & Lot) –

- 7<sup>th</sup> Street between Mill Avenue and 6<sup>th</sup> Street (6<sup>th</sup> Street at Maple remains open for E/W traffic)
- 440 South Mill Surface Lot (between Hackett House and Mill Avenue Shops)
- Maple Avenue, between 6<sup>th</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Street

#### Approximately 2:00 p.m. Closures (Peripheral Streets; In Order of Closure) –

- 4<sup>th</sup> Street, west of Mill to Maple
- 6<sup>th</sup> Street, from Mill Avenue to W/6 Tower 2 Entry Roundabout & east of Mill to 6<sup>th</sup> Street park
- 7<sup>th</sup> Street east of Mill to Myrtle

#### Approximately 5:00 p.m. Closures (Peripheral Streets; In Order of Closure) –

- 5<sup>th</sup> Street from Mill to Ash

#### Approximately 5:30 p.m. Closures –

- 5<sup>th</sup> Street, from Mill Avenue to Myrtle, including City Hall West Parking Lot

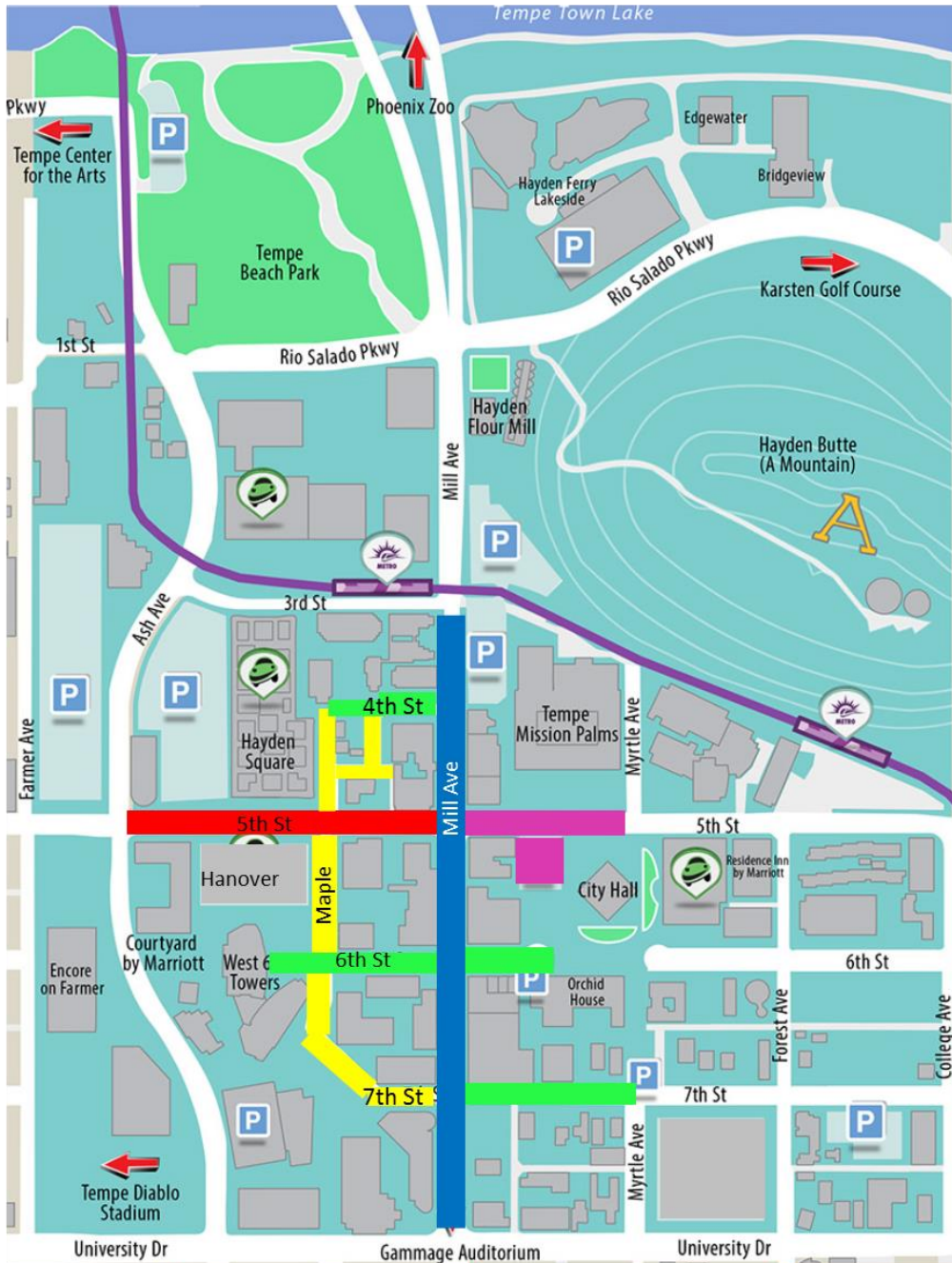
#### Approximately 6:30 p.m. Closures –

- Mill Avenue, from University Drive to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street

All Streets should re-open by 6:00 a.m. on Monday, December 4

## **DELIVERIES FOR DOWNTOWN TEMPE BUSINESSES:**

- We permit delivery entry ONLY at 5<sup>th</sup> and Ash (the west end of 5<sup>th</sup> Street). No deliveries will be allowed to enter from the East on 5<sup>th</sup> Street, and none on the North or South on Mill Avenue.
- Deliveries will be permitted throughout the night beginning at approximately 11:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 30; and 9:00 p.m. on Friday, December 1, Saturday, December 2, and Sunday, December 3.
- **All trucks must vacate the event area BEFORE 9:00 a.m. each day of the Festival.**
- Should your deliveries not arrive before 9:00 a.m., please contact DTA Operations Hotline at **480-894-1800** and we will determine the alternate load-in options available so that delivery can be accommodated, if possible.

If not possible, there are locations just **outside** the Festival's perimeter barricades where FedEx and UPS may park and hand-load deliveries throughout the day. Barricade entry is not permitted during open hours to the public; however, FedEx and UPS can stop and hand-truck deliveries at the following locations:

- 7<sup>th</sup> Street, east of Mill Avenue
  - 5<sup>th</sup> Street, west of Mill Avenue entering from Ash
  - 5<sup>th</sup> Street, east of Mill Avenue entering from Forest
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Street loading zones between Mill and Ash
- **In no event will deliveries be allowed after 9:00 a.m. on any day of the festival** except for U.S. Post Office deliveries which may require special arrangements.

## **PARKING VALIDATIONS:**

Downtown Tempe business parking validations **are only accepted at the City Hall Garage at 117 East 5<sup>th</sup> Street.** All other parking locations require payment in advance.

## **PARKING FOR DOWNTOWN TEMPE EMPLOYEES:**

Many employees have monthly parking permits which are color coded (see references below). In general, all employees should allow additional time to park during the event.

Downtown Tempe Authority, who produces the event and also manages parking in many of the downtown Tempe locations, will work with employees to meet their parking needs reasonably; however, it is the responsibility of all employees to make sure that they have secured their own parking permits.

Employees that normally park in private lots that are unavailable as a result of the event will be eligible to replacement parking permits valid in the 5<sup>th</sup> & Farmer Lot only.

- The 5<sup>th</sup> & Farmer Surface Lot will be open for Permit Parking only.
- On-Street Parking and small off street lots within the event perimeter will close between 7:00 am and 5:00 pm on Thursday, November 30. All on-street parking on Mill Avenue will close at 4:30 p.m.

- We will attempt to provide parking for all employees in their usual locations or alternate locations based on the following schedule:
  1. **Employees with 5<sup>th</sup> & Farmer Surface Lot passes** – Will be permitted to park in the lot on a space available basis.
  2. **Employees with Hayden Square Garage passes** – Will be permitted to park in the garage on a space available basis.
  3. **Employees with Hayden Square West Lot passes** – Will be permitted to park in the lot on a space available basis.
  4. **Employees with Brickyard Garage passes** – Will be permitted to park in the garage using the 7<sup>th</sup> Street entrance only.
  5. **Employees with Hanover Garage access cards** – Will be permitted to park in the garage using the 6<sup>th</sup> Street residence only entrance. This entrance is only available to card holders during times that Maple Avenue is closed.
  6. **Employees with passes for lots within the event venue** will be rerouted via DTA to 5<sup>th</sup> & Farmer Lot. Passes will be distributed to affected businesses the week prior to the event. No employee parking will be permitted within the event perimeter.

If your regular parking area is not listed above, and you feel your parking may be closed or affected, please contact the DTA Parking Operations Hotline at **(480) 894-1800** to make parking arrangements. Please do so before Thursday, November 30<sup>th</sup>, as no parking arrangements can be made after that date.

In general, please allow additional time to find a place to park, and get to work. We will do everything we can to meet your parking needs but it is still up to you to see that you have the necessary permits.

- METRO light rail provides free parking at 11 Valley Park and Ride so you can ride the train directly to the 3<sup>rd</sup> & Mill festival entrance. For details see [http://www.valleymetro.org/park\\_and\\_rides/mlr](http://www.valleymetro.org/park_and_rides/mlr) Locations are as follows:
  - 19<sup>th</sup> Ave/Dunlap Avenue – 415 spaces
  - 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Montebello Avenue – 794 spaces
  - 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Camelback Road – 410 spaces
  - 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Camelback Road – 123 spaces
  - Central Avenue/Camelback Road – 135 spaces
  - 38<sup>th</sup> Street/Washington Street – 189 spaces
  - Dorsey Lane/Apache Boulevard – 190 spaces
  - McClintock Road/Apache Boulevard – 300 spaces
  - Price - 101 Freeway/Apache Boulevard – 693 spaces
  - Sycamore Street/Main Street – 802 spaces

- Mesa Drive – 448 spaces

Avoid parking, and take the bus. ### **PUBLIC PARKING FOR CLIENTS AND CUSTOMERS:**

**Public Parking at the Festival:** There is paid parking available surrounding the Festival, and none within the actual venue itself. Since many garages and lots are privately owned, there is a charge that ranges from \$10 - \$20 but may be different at each location. Look for parking along Rio Salado Parkway, University, Ash, and College. For specific parking locations in Downtown Tempe, visit <http://www.downtowntempe.com/get-around/parking>

**Accessible Parking at the Festival:** The Tempe Festival of the Arts does not offer a wheelchair concession.

- All public lots and garages offer paid disabled access parking.
- There is no parking inside the event perimeter. All available on-street parking throughout Downtown Tempe is FREE to cars displaying required current disabled access license plates or placards.
- Dedicated accessible parking meters will be reserved along Ash Avenue between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Street, on 5<sup>th</sup> Street east of Mill and on 7<sup>th</sup> Street east of Mill, adjacent to the Festival venue. As always, on-street parking is free for vehicles displaying required current disabled access license plates or placards.
